

Ayva Privacy Policy

We, Ayva Construction, (collectively the “Company”, “We” or “Us”) respect your right to privacy and are committed to your protection through our compliance with this policy.

This privacy notice applies to all information collected through our Services including, but not limited to this website (our “website”) as well as any related services, sales, marketing, e-mail, text, phone, electronic messages, or events. Please read this privacy notice carefully as it will help you understand what we do with the information we collect.

By visiting or using our website or any subsidiary website or utilizing any of our services you are agreeing to this Privacy Policy. This policy as well as the information, services and resources contained in this site may be revised by the Company at any time without obligation to notify past, current, or prospective visitors. Your continued use of the site after changes have been made constitutes your acceptance of any new or amended terms. In no event shall Ayva Construction be liable for any indirect, special, incidental, or consequential damages arising out of any use of the information contained herein.

1. WHAT PERSONAL INFORMATION DO WE COLLECT?

We collect personal information in a variety of ways: information that you voluntarily provide to us when you express an interest in obtaining information about us or our services, when you participate in activities on the website, when you contact us, apply for a job or partnership, subscribe to mailing lists, text messages or other forms of communication.

We may collect personal information such as your name, phone number, e-mail address, postal/zip code, address, etc.; however, information collected depends on the context of your interactions with us and the website, the choices you make and the features you use.

We collect certain information when you visit, use, or navigate the website. This information does not reveal your specific identity (like your name or contact information) but may include, and is not limited to, device and usage information, such as your IP address, browser and device characteristics, operating system, language preferences, referring URLs, device name, country, location, information about how and when you use our website and other technical information. This information is primarily needed to maintain the security and operation of our website and for our internal analytics and reporting purposes.

When you contact us directly (email, phone, mail or completing an online form) we may record your comments and opinions. We may also record comments and opinions you express when responding to surveys, etc. We use this information to respond to your question or comment, to evaluate and improve our services and to inform our marketing and advertising activities.

We ask all personal information provided to us be complete and accurate and to be notified of any changes.

We also may collect information provided directly by the user such as e-mail address, postal address, telephone number, and through cookies and similar technologies such as location

information, including shared location services on mobile, desktop and tablet devices, internet connection, interactions with advertising and applications on third-party websites and services, and information posted or submitted to our website. Transaction information, etc. may also be collected. These collections are for the use of business and marketing practices. Please be aware some data is only collected with your consent, while other data may be collected without direct user permission, but within the legal rights of the user.

We may use technologies to collect information about your online activities over time and across third-party websites or other online services (behavioral tracking). The information we collect automatically may include personal information, or we may maintain it or associate it with personal information we collect in other ways or receive from third parties. This helps us to improve our website and to deliver a better and more personalized service. We do not collect personal information automatically, but we may tie this information to personal information about you that we collect from other sources you provide to us.

Our website is not intended for children under 16 years of age. No one under age 16 may provide any personal information to or on the website. We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 16. If you are under 16, do not use or provide any information on this website or on or through any of its features/registrations on the website, make any purchases/orders through the website or use any of the interactive or public comment features of this website or provide any information about yourself to us, including your name, address, telephone number, e-mail address or any screen name or username you may use. If we learn we have collected or received personal information from a child under 16 without verification of parental consent, we will delete that information. Third-party Use of Cookies and Other Tracking Technologies

Some content or applications, including advertisements, on the website are served by third parties, including advertisers, ad networks and servers, content providers and application providers. These third parties may use cookies alone or in conjunction with web beacons or other tracking technologies to collect information about you when you use our website. The information they collect may be associated with your personal information or they may collect information, including personal information, about your online activities over time and across different websites and other online services. They may use this information to provide you with interest-based advertising or other targeted content. We do not control these third parties' tracking technologies or how they may be used. 2. WILL YOUR INFORMATION BE SHARED WITH ANYONE?

We may process, share and/or disclose your data that we hold to subsidiaries, affiliates, agencies, contractors, service providers and other third parties we use to support our business and who are bound by contractual obligations to keep personal information confidential; as well as the following:

Consent: We may process your data if you have given us specific consent to use your personal information for a specific purpose. We may also disclose aggregated information about our users and information that does not identify any individual, without restriction.

Legitimate Interests: We may process your data when it is reasonably necessary to achieve our legitimate business interests.

Performance of a Contract: Where we have entered into a contract with you, we may process your personal information to fulfill the terms of our contract or to fulfill the purpose for which you provided the information.

Legal Obligations: We may disclose your information where we are legally required to do so in order to comply with applicable law, governmental requests, a judicial proceeding, court order, or legal process, such as in response to a court order or a subpoena (including in response to public authorities to meet national security or law enforcement requirements).

Vital Interests: We may disclose your information where we believe it is necessary to investigate, prevent, or act regarding potential violations of our policies, suspected fraud, situations involving potential threats to the safety of any person and illegal activities, or as evidence in litigation in which we are involved.

More specifically, we may need to process your data or share your personal information in the following situations:

Business Transfers: We may share or transfer your information in connection with, or during negotiations of, any merger, sale of company assets, financing, or acquisition of all or a portion of our business to another company.

Google/Apple Platform APIs: We may share your information with certain Google/Apple Platform APIs (e.g., Google Maps API, Place API, etc.). We may obtain and store on your device ('cache') your location. You may revoke your consent anytime by contacting us at the contact details provided at the end of this document.

3. DO WE USE COOKIES AND OTHER TRACKING TECHNOLOGIES?

We may use cookies and similar tracking technologies (like web beacons and pixels) to access or store information.

4. IS YOUR INFORMATION TRANSFERRED INTERNATIONALLY?

Our servers are located in the United States. If you are accessing our website from outside the U.S., please be aware that your information may be transferred to, stored, and processed by us in our facilities and by those third parties with whom we may share your personal information.

5. HOW LONG DO WE KEEP YOUR INFORMATION?

We will only keep your personal information for as long as it is necessary for the purposes set out in this privacy notice, unless a longer retention period is required or permitted by law (such as tax,

accounting, or other legal requirements).

When we have no ongoing legitimate business need to process your personal information, we will either delete or anonymize such information.

6. WHAT ARE YOUR PRIVACY RIGHTS?

Cookies and similar technologies: Most Web browsers are set to accept cookies by default. If you prefer, you can usually choose to set your browser to remove cookies and to reject cookies. If you choose to remove cookies or reject cookies, this could affect certain features or services of our website.

7. CONTROLS FOR DO-NOT-TRACK FEATURES

Most web browsers and some mobile operating systems and mobile applications include a Do-Not-Track ("DNT") feature or setting you can activate to signal your privacy preference not to have data about your online browsing activities monitored and collected. 8. DO CALIFORNIA RESIDENTS HAVE SPECIFIC PRIVACY RIGHTS?
